- General purpose motors that today meet EPACT levels will need to meet premium efficiency levels in 2010.
- General purpose motors that were exempt from EPACT because of voltage, mounting, etc. will need to meet EPACT in 2010.
- Motors that cannot be used in most applications such as special shafts, blowers or non-standard frequencies are exempt from any regulations for efficiencies.
